

# Set Custom Spam Filter

## Step 1:

1. Login with your Email Address and Password
2. Select Spam Filters Button

Spam Filters

Set your personal spam filtering level to a level that stops unwanted mail with out blocking the mail you want.

## Step 2: (System Default Setting is set to LOW and Move to Spam Folder)

1. Select the Filter Level of Spam you would like. (No Spam meaning you will receive NO Spam)
2. Select the Action to take on Spam. Move to spam folder means you may check the spam you receive in your Web Mail Spam box; Delete will not save any Spam on system.
3. Click Change Spam Filters to apply your changes

Filter Level	Description
<input type="radio"/> No Spam	Filters ALL incoming email except addresses in your Webmail Address Book.
<input type="radio"/> Very Low Spam	Heavily filters incoming email. May catch some legitimate email.
<input type="radio"/> Low	Should filter most spam mail. May catch a low amount of legitimate email.
<input type="radio"/> Medium	Filters medium amount of spam mail. Unlikely to catch legitimate email.
<input type="radio"/> High	Filters low amounts of spam mail. Should not catch any legitimate email.
<input type="radio"/> No Filtering	Does not filter email.

**Action to take on Spam**

Move to Spam Folder: Moves all filtered email to Spam folder.

Delete Immediately: Filtered email is deleted immediately. Deleted email cannot be retrieved!
